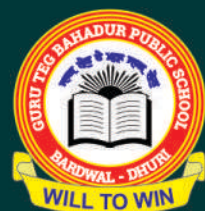
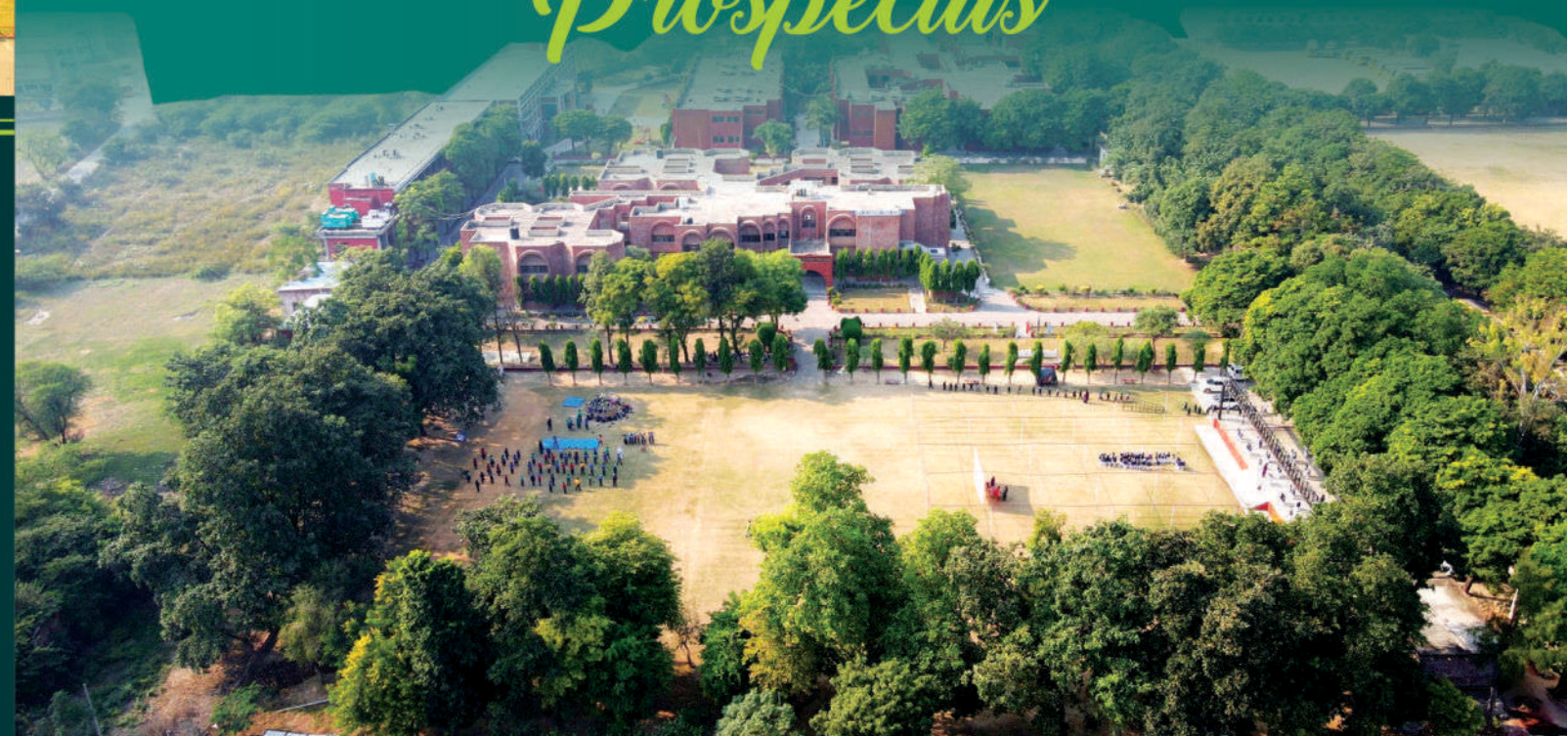

Guru Teg Bahadur Ji was the youngest son of Sri Guru Hargobind Ji and Bibi Nanki. From a young age, Guru Teg Bahadur Ji was trained in the martial arts of swordsmanship and horse riding, as well as religious training by the wise Baba Buddha Ji and Bhai Gurdas Ji. During His young years, Guru Teg Bahadur Ji fought along with His Father at Guru Hargobind Ji's fierce and bloody last battle in 1634, at Kartarpur. His Father witnessed His extraordinary bravery and His expert control of the sword. Therefore, Guru Ji was so proud of Him that He changed His name from "Teg Mal" to Teg Bahadur (Brave Swordsman).

Then, Guru Teg Bahadur Ji spend 26 years of His life in deep meditation with His wife, Mata Gujri, in a village called Baba Bakala. When Guru Har Krishan Ji left this world, He didn't appoint the next Guru. Instead, He spoke the words "Baba Bakala". The search was now on for the true Guru. Everyone was either looking for the Guru Ji or a Person pretending to be a Guru.

Finally, Bhai Makhan Shah Labana located Guru Teg Bahadur Ji. He recognized Him as the Guru because a short while earlier, when his ship had been sinking, he had prayed to God to save him, and in return, had promised to give five gold coins. When he returned to shore safely, he gave every "fake" Guru one gold coin and they accepted it happily. However, when he gave one to Guru Teg Bahadur Ji, Guru Ji asked him, "Where are the other four coins you had promised"? Guru Ji did not need the money, but when He asked that question, the true 9th Guru was finally revealed to the people. He transformed into the Divine Light in the year 1664 A.D.

The town of Anandpur Sahib was founded by him. Guru Teg Bahadur can aptly be called the peerless martyr in the history of the World. He laid down his life for the right of the people to freedom of worship. Hence it was for this cause that he went to Delhi of his own accord to face martyrdom for the defence of the downtrodden Hindus. About the martyrdom of Guru Teg Bahadur, this is what Guru Gobind Singh wrote in Bichitar Natak.

Teg Bahadur is no more, The world says, Alas! Alas! The Heaven sings blessing, Welcoming His return home. The angels sing, The Victor Comes Home, The Victor Comes Home, God opened His arms to Welcome the victorious Warrior back to His Home. May we implore Guru Teg Bahadur to let us enjoy his grace so that we are able to put his teachings into practice and thus pay him the homage he deserves".

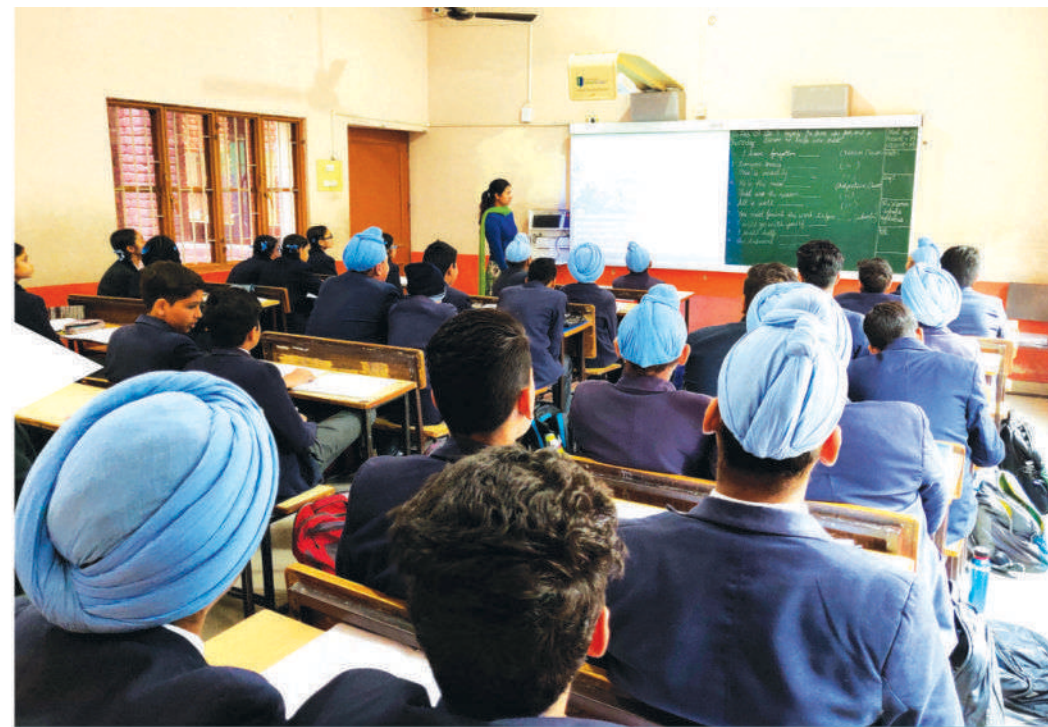

MEDICAL FACILITY

Free medical insurance is provided to the students of GTBPS. If a student meets with an accident, he can get the charges of the medical treatment upto Rs. 50000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand Only).

In case of the death of the father by accident, the child can get free education for five years.

REGISTRATION & ADMISSION

Admission is open to all boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed or social status provided, they are mentally and physically fit, having attained the minimum age of three years.

Application form for registration to all classes is available at the school office.

Entrance tests are held in the month of January. Results are declared according to merit and admissions are made subject to vacancies.

Name of the child can be registered for admission from Nursery to class IX. At the time of admission the parents are required to submit, a birth certificate from the Registrar of Birth for admission to Nursery class. An affidavit will be accepted.

Students migrating from other schools must submit Transfer certificate, School leaving certificate and progress report from the previous school.

Registration does not guarantee admission.

Admission to class XI is done on the basis of class X result. The school conducts Interview and Entrance test at the time of admission. The student admitted during mid-term shall pay tuition fee and other charges for the entire academic year.

The Principal reserves the right of granting or refusing admission to anyone who seeks admission to school.



WITHDRAWAL

If a child is withdrawn during the school session, a prior written notice of one month for withdrawal must be given, failing which fee for the said period will be charged.

Those who plan to leave after the academic session should inform the school in writing by 28th February, failing which fee for one month will be charged.

Those who submit their applications for withdrawal in March shall have to pay the annual charges and the dues for the month of March.

Students who are withdrawn from the school in the month of May (before the summer vacations), must pay fee for the month of June.

Transfer certificate will be issued and security deposit released on the clearance of all school dues. Security refund will be released within a month of the request.

(Security Cheques will be posted on request. Parents may leave self addressed stamped envelope with the school office.)

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

Attendance in the school for the school session is compulsory for all students. Attendance on the first day of school after vacations is compulsory. If a child is not present on the reopening day a fine of Rs. 10/- shall be levied for each day.

Non-availability of reservation will not be accepted as an excuse for absence on the reopening day.

No pupil shall absent himself / herself from the class without obtaining prior permission of the class teacher. If prior permission cannot be sought on grounds of health or unforeseen circumstances, an application for leave must be sent to the class teacher, not later than the following day.

The class teacher shall sanction leave up to two days and leave for more than two days shall be sanctioned by the Principal. Absence without application will invite a penalty of Rs. 5/- per day.

All applications for leave should be addressed to the Principal and submitted to the class teacher.

No pupil shall be eligible for promotion unless he/she has minimum attendance of 75% of the total number of working days of the school in the academic year. This rule holds good in respect of all classes. Parents are particularly requested to take note of this rule.

If a student remains absent for 6 consecutive days, his/her name shall be struck off from the school rolls and the student may be readmitted only at the discretion of the Principal.

Once a student joins his/her class on a working day he/she will not be permitted to leave the school during school hours except in case of emergency. Parents should come personally to take their ward with the permission of the Principal.

Leave will not ordinarily be granted on the first and the last day of the school term.
